PREREQUISITES: This is a Student Affiliate Event. See prerequisite details below. (Participants on all ensemble teams must be Student Affiliate members and earn a score of 70 or higher on the state-graded TMTA Student Affiliate Theory Test. See Theory and Ensemble pages in this Handbook for complete theory rules and information. Requirements may also be found in the TMTA Handbook on tmta.org.)

TEACHER PRE-PLANNING: September through December 2019. Contact the director of the ensemble your student(s) wish to participate in. Primo and secondo parts will be assigned by the director for the best ensemble balance.

REGISTRATION: Postmarked by **Friday, January 31, 2020**. Include **Intent Form** (see below) and one check per studio for student registration fees. Checks must be made out to FWMTA. Please also email **Intent Form** to the chairperson by due date – **Jimmy Angeles, 4100 Lovell Ave., Apt. A, Ft. Worth, 76107.**

FEES for High School and Intermediate #1 and #2: \$25.00 per student
(includes local fee - \$13 and state fee - \$12)

FEES for Local Team: \$15.00 per student

TEAM AUDITIONS: Saturday, February 1, 2020, 9:00 AM at Texas Wesleyan University. Students must play a solo performance of the **entire piece** for the team director. Memorization is not required. Students must bring the completed and signed **Parent and Student Contract** (included below) to the audition. The director will judge the student's ability to play correct notes and rhythms and follow a beat with the director. Each student will be allotted a 6-minute audition time.

Make-up auditions will be held on **Sunday, February 2, 2020** by appointment only with ensemble directors. Make-ups should only be used for legitimate conflicts and must be approved by the ensemble chair.

Ensemble Team Information

Fort Worth Music Teachers Association (FWMTA,) sends three ensemble teams to the annual state convention of Texas Music Teachers Association (TMTA):

High School Team: This team may include advanced 8th grade students. This team performs on the TMTA High School/Young Artist Ensemble Programs.

Intermediate Team: This team is for students in 8th grade and under. These teams perform on the TMTA Texas American Programs.

Elementary Team: This team is for 5th and under. This team performs on the TMTA Elementary Programs.

Local Ensemble Team: This team **ONLY** performs on the Honors Program in June. This team is for students in grades 1-6, or for older beginners. This team is a good choice for students who have never participated in an ensemble before and who are interested in learning more about FWMTA Ensembles.

- *I understand that parents are responsible for transportation to all rehearsals and performances, including the State Ensemble Performance at the Convention in Waco.
